Metallised and non-metallised polyester screen fabrics made of 100 % intrinsic flame retardant yarns, in various colours, produced with fibres and finished with flame retardant products accepted by Oeko-Tex®; produced by using materials certified according to Oeko-Tex® Standard 100.

The results of the inspection made according to Oeko-Tex® Standard 100, **product class IV** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the standard presently established for decoration material.

The certified articles fulfil the requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo-dyes, nickel, etc.) as well as the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass).
